Second menu - option 5. *Failure to do so may result in the fire department being needlessly dispatched to investigate the fire.*

## REGULATIONS:

Outdoor burning/fires in Dover Borough is regulated by Chapter 77 of the Dover Borough Code. A copy of the ordinance is available upon request.

The following is a summary of Section 77-3.

1. Fires may not be closer than 25 feet to any building.
2. Fires shall only be allowed to burn between sunrise and sunset.
3. Fires shall be allowed to burn only when an adult is present to regulate and control the burning during the entire time the fire is in existence.
4. Fires must be attended at all times and adequately contained.
5. The person attending the fire must be equipped with necessary tools to permit that person to effectively control the fire.
6. The person obtaining the permit shall be responsible to see that no materials such as tires, roofing materials, wet garbage or other substances which are likely to emit noxious odors or dense smoke or any other materials which are likely to be detrimental to the air quality of Dover Borough, York County, Pennsylvania, are ignited in any fire.

**PERMIT VALID FOR 15 DAYS FROM DATE OF ISSUE.**

THE HOLDER OF THIS PERMIT IS SOLELY RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY DAMAGE TO PROPERTY AND IS AWARE OF AND SHALL COMPLY WITH CHAPTER 77.
